

TOWN OF RICHLAND ANNUAL PUBLIC MEETING  
APRIL 18, 2023 Minutes

1. Chairman, David Jelinek, called the Annual Public Meeting to order at 6:00 P.M.
  - A. The Pledge of Allegiance was said. The following board members present were: Chairman -David Jelinek, Supervisors-Aaron Palmer and Matt Schmitz. Others: Treasurer-Jane Ewing, Clerk- Kayla Williams.
  - B. It was noted that the meeting was properly posted outside the Town Garage and on the Town's Website.
  - C. Aaron Palmer made a motion to approve the agenda; it was seconded by Linda Wymer. The motion carried.
  - D. Ed Wells made a motion to approve the Annual Public Meeting minutes from April 19, 2022, it was seconded Jane Ewing. The motion carried.
2. The Town's 2022 financial report was given by Kayla Williams, Town Clerk. The town's revenue for 2022 was \$1,752,903.36. Town expenditures for 2022 were \$1,662,287.62. The end of year bank account balances total \$779,249.80. The Town has no debt.
3. Jane Ewing, the town's treasurer, reported that the Town's depositories are: Richland County Bank, WCCU Credit Union, Royal Bank, Community First Bank and Peoples Community Bank. Aaron Palmer made a motion to keep the town's depositories the same. The motion was seconded by Matt Schmitz. The motion carried.
4. The Town Chairman, David Jelinek, gave the town road report. Hustler's Ridge, new culverts on several roads and brushing on Maple Grove. In 2022, the town used discretionary funds for Hillview Road and Maple Grove Road. TSBR is still snowplowing and maintaining town roads.
5. There were no requests to make changes to compensation for elected officials. A motion was made by Dave Jelinek to leave town officials compensation the same it was seconded by Aaron Palmer. The motion carried.
6. The date of the 2022 Annual Public Meeting was set for Tuesday: April 16, 2024.
7. A motion was made by Linda Wymer and seconded by Matt Schmitz to adjourn the Annual Public Meeting at 6:10 P.M. The motion carried.
